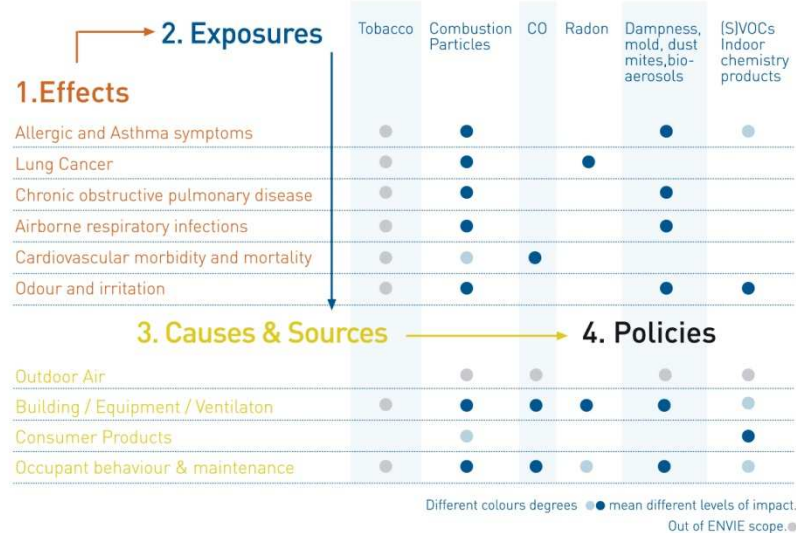

Workshop Objectives

To collect contributions from EU projects, or others, dealing with health effects related to IAQ (causes/exposures) consider the following questions:

- “The EnVIE project concept - starting from some key health impacts and working step by step towards policy implications - is visualised in the graphic below. In which way would your project contribute to the issues of this concept?”
- “Does your project link occupant health indicators to IAQ exposures, sources and/or preventive measures? If so what are the main results & findings?”
- “Which particular steps of progress have you observed in the recent years regarding knowledge, practice and policies on IAQ and health?”
- “What are the most relevant (technical or administrative) obstacles hindering the improvement of good, healthy indoor environment?”
- “What would be your most urgent/critical proposals or suggestions for EU policies and guidelines on IAQ and health, including R&D?”



The aim of this workshop is to collect the most updated information, identified in the context of the EU R&D projects, on the causes and related preventive measures for the impact of indoor air quality on health. This way, on the one hand we will be able to incorporate all that information in the report under preparation for October 2008 on ‘EU Policies on IAQ & Health Effects’ and, on the other hand, the pertinent results from the different projects can be somehow immediately made relevant for policy making purposes.
