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## Guidance

**MISSION** The Quality Movement™ (Perdicoulis, 2014a)

**FIELD** Scientific and technical communication (Perdicoulis, 2014b)

**SCOPE** Oral communication — e.g. scholarly presentations, lectures, moderation, debates, oral examinations

**INTENT** Learn verbal exposition, argumentation, interaction, and develop a personal style

## Themes

**PRESENTATION** Idea, scope, storyboard, argument, structure, vocabulary

**ORAL EXAMINATION** Content, dress code, body language, verbal style

**DEBATE** Scope, argument, points of view/ perspectives, margins

**MODERATION** Stakeholders, public, panel, objectives, guidelines

## Logistics

**ACTIVITIES** Live sessions in ‘modes’ (e.g. practice, innovation, experimentation)

**SESSIONS** Groups small enough to maintain good interaction (ca. 2 hours)

**OUTPUT** Events; Scholarly presentations, lectures, moderation, debates, oral examinations
