Libraries catalogue and shelve their collections either by the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC, §1) or the Library of Congress Classification (LCC, §2). The resulting ‘call numbers’ (i.e. resource IDs) serve to locate physical resources in a library, but do not have universal validity — contrary to ISBNs or ISSNs, for instance.
