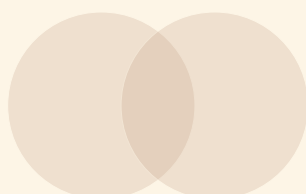


Note

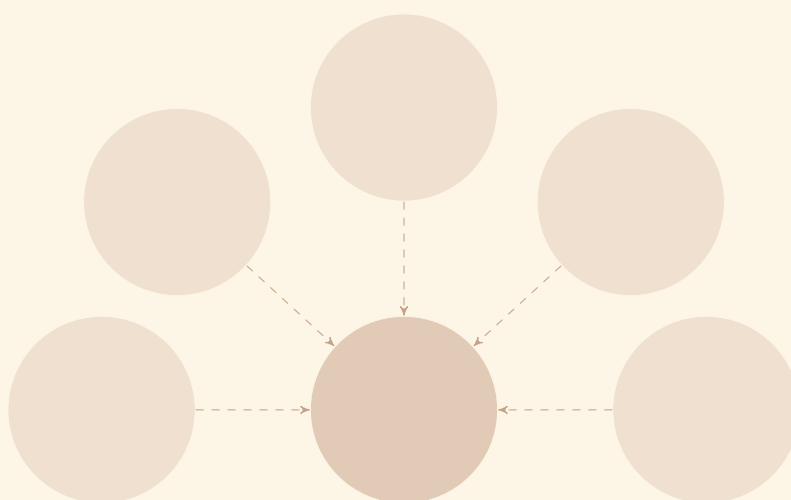
1 Union

1.1 Direct (merger)



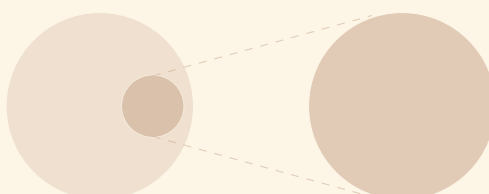
merging data, information, or knowledge

1.2 Indirect (influence)



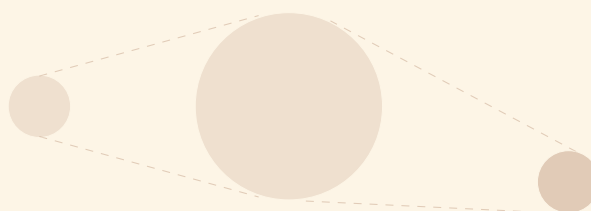
multiple influences
